Spark: Learning the Process



She formerly taught advanced screenwriting Pepperdine's Seaver College and has published more than 130 articles in local and national publications. Dodd was also formerly the academic editor of the peer-reviewed Graziadio Business Review at the Pepperdine Graziadio Business School, where she taught electives "Presentations & Stories" and "Business Storytelling." Currently, she works as an editor and a consultant internationally and is earning her Ph.D. in Global Leadership and Change, focusing on spark—the moment that ignites creativity.

EFFECTIVE SELF-EDITING



Jenny Margotta used all the right words and all her beautiful incite to make this a workshop to remember.



ANDREW ROTH


